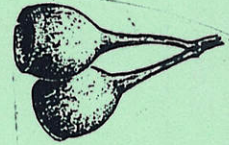
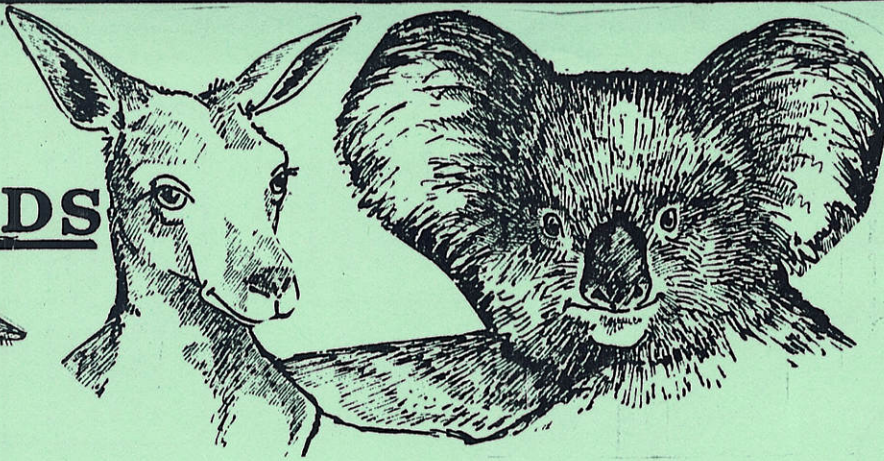

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- ★ All plants and animals are protected.
- ★ Light fires only in fireplaces provided.
- ★ Shooting is not permitted in the park.
- ★ No dogs, cats or horses are allowed in the park, except for dogs on leads in the Pound Bend picnic area and on the northern river frontage, and horses on the horse trail in Pound Bend Reserve.
- ★ Place litter in bins.

PARK CLOSING TIMES
The entry gates at Pound Bend and Jumping Creek are normally closed as follows

The lightly-wooded landscape of **JUMPING CREEK RESERVE** is very pleasant for walking – especially if you are interested in birds and wildflowers. Most walking tracks lead from the three picnic areas.

Open woodlands, old mine diggings, excellent spring wildflower displays and varied bird life are some of the main features at **BLACK FLAT**.

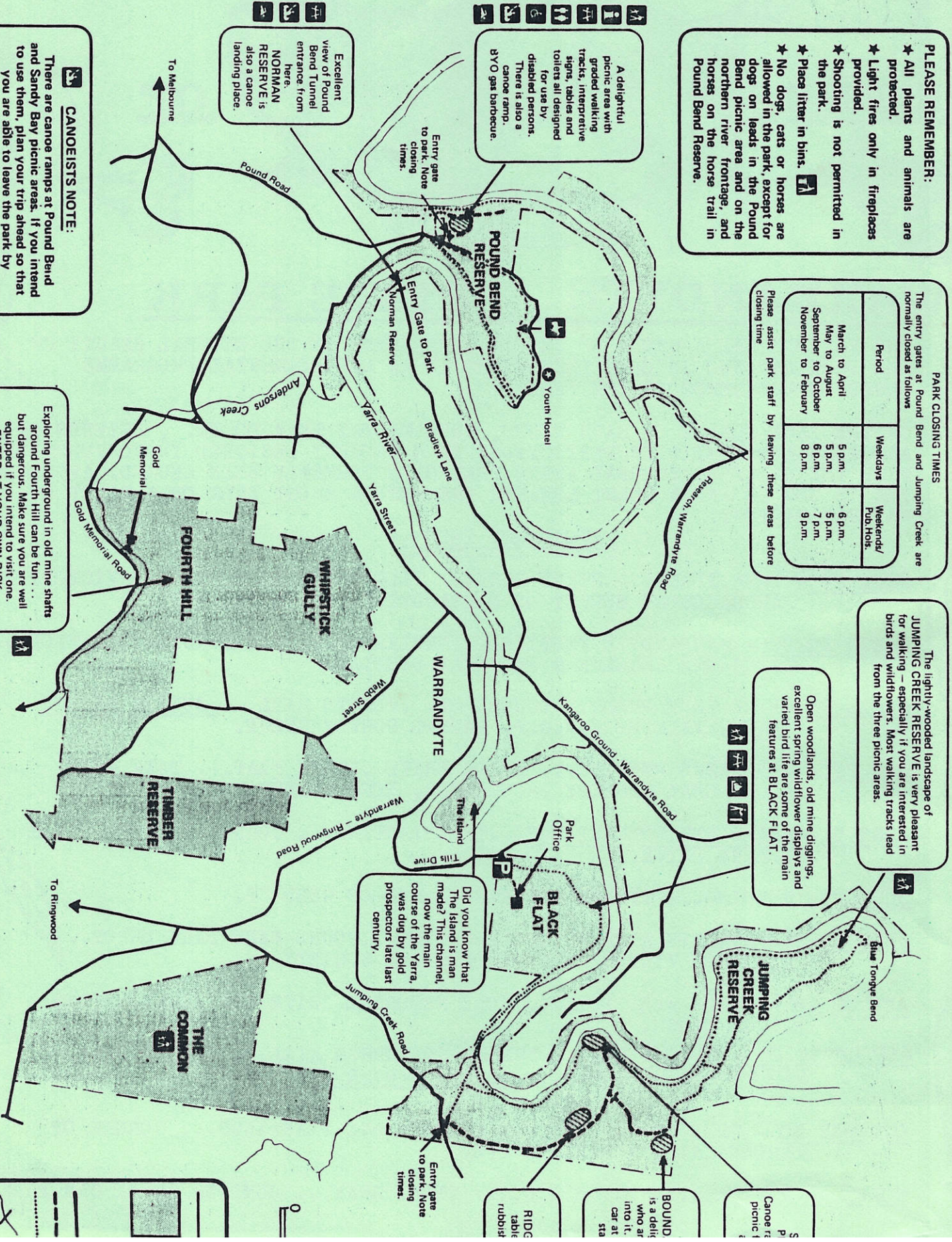
A delightful picnic area with graded walking tracks, interpretive signs, tables and toilets all designed for use by disabled persons. There is also a canoe ramp. BYO gas barbecue.

Excellent view of Pound Bend Tunnel entrance from here. **NORMAN RESERVE** is also a canoe landing place.

CANOEISTS NOTE:
There are canoe ramps at Pound Bend and Sandy Bay picnic areas. If you intend to use them, plan your trip ahead so that you are able to leave the park by closing time.

Exploring underground in old mine shafts around Fourth Hill can be fun... but dangerous. Make sure you are well equipped if you intend to visit one. **ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

Did you know that The Island is man made? This channel, now the main course of the Yarra, was dug by gold prospectors late last century.



BOUND is a delightful picnic area who are invited to bring their car at the picnic site.

RIDGE is a delightful picnic area with tables and rubbish bins.
